



# Referendum 27th Nov 2005 (Gentechfrei-Initiative)






#### Scope of the moratorium



- For 5 years (Nov 2010) strictly no cultivation of GM crops (incl. no importation of GM seeds)
- Strictly no genetic modification to breed animals producing milk, meat, eggs, wool etc.
- Not subject to the moratorium: GMOs in medical health, research/field trials
- Imported food/feed: More than 99% gmo-free (regulation by approved legislation)

#### Half time moratorium: it works





- No GMO produced in Switzerland nor imported
- No problems about coexistence and contamination

#### Good reasons for prolongation




#### Advantages of GMO-free food production:
